With over 450 singers, Youth Singers excels in the area of both show choir and concert choir and is known for in-house arrangements of all styles of music, larger than life productions, and a high-energy music making experience for all members of our community.

Kathryn Parrotta (B. Music Voice Performance, M.Mus Choral Conducting) has been teaching with the Youth Singers of Calgary since 2003. 
